MORNING MESSAGE

“When Jesus Went to Church”

Luke 21:1-4

- I. WHERE HE SAT (Mark 12:41)
 - A. He sat in a place where He could not be seen
 - B. He sat in a place where He could see
 - C. He sat in a place where He could specify
 1. 1 Samuel 16:7, “for the Lord seeth not as man seeth; for man looketh on the outward appearance, but the Lord looketh on the heart”
- II. WHO HE SAW (v.1a, 2)
 - A. He saw the wealthy give (v.1a)
 1. “Rich” refers to those who are abounding
 2. In Luke 12:16 it describes the rich farmer
 3. In Luke 16:19 it describes the rich man who died
 - B. He saw the widow give (v.2)
 1. “Poor” means needy
 2. A “mite” has been called “the penny of the Bible”
 - C. The wealthy and the widow describe two kinds of givers
 1. Some give for the applause of men
 2. Some give for the approval of God
- III. WHAT JESUS SAID (vv.3-4)
 - A. Hear His response (v.3)
 - B. Hear His reason (v.4)
