“Preparing to Kill the Lamb”

Luke 22:1-13

 1. He was a threat to their power
 - a. John 11:47-48, “Then gathered the chief priests and the Pharisees a council, and said, What do we, for this man doeth many miracles? If we let him thus alone, all men will believe on him: and the Romans shall come and take away both our place and nation”
 2. He was a threat to their productivity
 - C. The phobia (v.2c)

 1. John 6:64, “For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were that believed not, and who should betray him”
 2. John 6:70, “Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil? He spake of Judas Iscariot the son of Simon”
