MORNING MESSAGE

“The First Lord’s Supper”

Luke 22:14-20

- I. THE ARRIVAL OF THE SUPPER (v.14)
 - A. Jesus was on a divine time schedule
 1. He was born on time
 - a. Galatians 4:4, “But when the fulness of time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law”
 2. He began His ministry on time
 - a. Mark 1:14-15, “Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God, and saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel”
 3. He will die on time
 - a. John 7:30, “Then they sought to take him: but no man laid hands on him, because his hour was not yet come”
 - b. John 8:20, “and no man laid hands on him: for his hour was not yet come”
 4. But now “the hour was come”
- II. THE ANTICIPATION OF THE SUPPER (vv.15-18)
 - A. We sense the heart of Jesus (v.15)
 - B. We sense the hope of Jesus (vv.16-18)
- III. THE APPLICATION OF THE SUPPER (vv.19-20)
 - A. The bread represents His body (v.19)
 - B. The cup represents His blood (v.20)
 1. 1 Peter 1:18-20, “Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold...But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot: Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you”
