- I. IT WAS A STARTLING TALK (vv.21-23)

  - A. He gave them a principle (vv.24-27a)
  - B. He gave them a pattern (v.27b)
  - C. He gave them a promise (vv.28-30)
- III. IT WAS A SOBERING TALK (vv.31-34)
  - A. The desire of Satan (vv.31-32)
    1. “Desire” means to demand
    2. “Sift” means to shake
  - B. The declaration of Peter (v.33)
    1. Peter overestimated himself
    2. Peter underestimated his enemy
  - C. The disclosure of Jesus (v.34)
    1. “I tell thee” emphasizes what He is about to say is true
    2. “Deny” means to disown or have no connection with

  - B. They will protect themselves (vv.36b,38)
