MORNING MESSAGE

“The Place”

Luke 22:39-46

- I. IT WAS THE PLACE OF PRAYER (vv.39-41)
 - A. Luke tells us where He went (v.39)
 1. Gethsemane was Jesus’ place of prayer
 - B. Luke tells us what He said (v.40)
 1. The disciple’s world was about to change
 - C. Luke tells us what He did (v.41)
 1. He went a “stone’s cast” further
 2. He “kneeled down, and prayed”
 - D. Luke does not tell us the whole story; Matthew does in 26:36-46
 1. There was the majority (v.36)
 2. There was the minority (vv.37-38)
 3. There was the Master (v.39)
- II. IT WAS THE PLACE OF PASSION (vv.42-44)
 - A. This was no ordinary prayer
 1. It was an authentic prayer (v.42)
 2. It was an answered prayer (v.43)
 3. It was an agonizing prayer (v.44)
- III. IT WAS THE PLACE OF PERSPECTIVE (vv.45-46)
 - A. There are two perspectives from “the place”
 1. The disciples’ perspective was sorrow
 - a. “Sorrow” means despair
 2. The Lord’s perspective was success
