MORNING MESSAGE

“There They Crucified Him”

Luke 23:33

- I. “THERE” SPEAKS OF THE PLACE
  - A. The place of the crucifixion is Calvary
    - 1. Only Luke uses the word Calvary
    - 2. The other gospel writers use the word Golgotha
    - 3. It means “the skull”
- II. “THEY” SPEAKS OF THE PEOPLE
  - A. The people who crucified Jesus are called “they”
    - 1. Luke uses that ambiguous term at least 7 times
    - 2. “They” includes the chief priests, the Sanhedrin, Pilate, Herod, Roman soldiers, and the Jewish people
- III. “CRUCIFIED” SPEAKS OF THE PUNISHMENT
  - A. Death by crucifixion was the most painful method of execution devised by man
    - 1. This is sin at its worst
    - 2. This is God at His best
- IV. “HIM” SPEAKS OF THE PERSON
  - A. The person being crucified is Jesus, God’s Son
