MORNING MESSAGE

“The Soulwinner...Weeping”

Psalms 126:6

- I. TEARS REFLECT OUR CARE
  - A. Jeremiah wept over Israel because he cared
    - 1. Jeremiah 9:1, “Oh that my head were waters, and mine eyes a fountain of tears, that I might weep day and night for the slain of the daughter of my people”
  - B. Jesus wept over Jerusalem because He cared
    - 1. Luke 19:41, “And when he was come near, he beheld the city, and wept over it”
  - C. Paul wept over the churches because he cared
    - 1. Acts 20:19, “Night and day I was with you in many tears”
    - 2. Acts 20:31, “I warned you with tears”
    - 3. 2 Corinthians 2:14, “I wrote you with tears”
- II. TEARS REFLECT OUR COMPASSION
  - A. Jesus was often moved with compassion
    - 1. Matthew 9:36, “But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd”
    - 2. Matthew 15:32, “And Jesus called his disciples unto him and said, I have compassion on the multitude, because they continue with me now three days, and have nothing to eat”
- III. TEARS REFLECT OUR CONVICTIONS
  - A. I have some basic Bible convictions
    - 1. I believe the Bible is the inerrant Word of God; it is absolutely true in every way
    - 2. I believe God created everything that is in seven literal days, including the first man, Adam
    - 3. I believe Adam disobeyed God and sin came into the world so that now “all have sinned and come short of the glory of God”
    - 4. I believe God provided a way of forgiveness by sending His only Son, Jesus, to die on a cross for our sin and be raised from the dead
    - 5. I believe that all who receive Jesus will be forgiven of their sin and spend eternity in heaven
    - 6. I believe that all who refuse Jesus will die in their sin and spend eternity in hell
