MORNING MESSAGE

“The Soulwinner...Sowing”

Psalm 126:6

- I. IT IS A PRECIOUS SEED
 - A. The Bible is different than any other book
 1. The psalmist called it “precious”
 - a. The English word is found 58 times in the Old Testament
 - b. The Hebrew word translated “precious” is only found once
 - c. It means to be of great value or worth
 2. There is a solemn warning to the modern church in the book of Leviticus
 1. Leviticus 19:19, “Ye shall keep my statutes. Thou shalt not let thy cattle gender with a diverse kind: **thou shalt not sow thy field with mingled seed**: neither shall a garment mingled of linen and woolen come upon thee”
 - a. “Mingled” means diverse kinds; two kinds of seeds
 - b. NIV, “Do not...sow your fields with two kinds of seeds”
- II. IT IS A PURE SEED
 - A. The Bible declares itself to be pure
 1. Psalm 12:6, “The words of the Lord are pure words: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times”
 2. Psalm 19:18, “The statutes of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the Lord is pure, enlightening the eyes”
 3. Proverbs 30:5, “Every word of God is pure: he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him”
 - a. To say that the Bible is pure is to say that it is without error
 - B. The strongest statement on the Bible was penned by Paul in 2 Timothy 3:16-17, “All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: that the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works”
 1. It speaks of the author of scripture
 2. It speaks of the authority of scripture
 3. It speaks of the aim of scripture
- III. IT IS A POWERFUL SEED
 - A. The Bible is a powerful book
