MORNING MESSAGE

“The Soulwinner...Reaping”

Psalm 126:6

- I. THE ASSURANCE OF THE SOULWINNER – “shall doubtless come again”
 - A. The Hebrew word translated “doubtless” means “no doubt about it”
 1. The same word is found two other times in scripture
 - a. Number 14:30, “Doubtless ye shall come into the land, concerning which I swear to make you dwell therein”
 - b. 2 Samuel 5:19, “The Lord said to David, Go up: for I will doubtless deliver the Philistines into thine hand”
 2. This a promise from God to the soulwinner that if you will go, weep, and sow the Word of God, you will lead someone to Jesus
 3. This is not a promise from God to the soulwinner that you will win everyone you talk to
 - a. “Goeth” means “keep on going”
- II. THE ATTITUDE OF THE SOULWINNER – “with rejoicing”
 - A. The Hebrew word translated “rejoicing” means a shrill sound, shouting, or singing
 1. The most joyous thing in the Christian life is to lead someone to Jesus
 - B. Nothing causes churches to get loud like souls getting saved
- III. THE ACHIEVEMENT OF THE SOULWINNER – “bringing his sheaves with him”
 - A. A “sheave” is bundled stalks of grain; wheat, rye, oats, or barley
 1. Women and children would go into the fields, cut the stalks of grain, and bundle them or tie them together
 2. Men would load the sheaves onto carts and carry them to the threshing floor
 - B. This is a picture of evangelism
