Acts 4:1-22

  - B. What stumped the Sanhedrin (vv.15-16)
    - 1. They were dumbfounded (v.15)
    - 2. They were distressed (v.16)

  - A. The threatening of Peter and John (vv.17-18)
  - B. The testimony of Peter and John (vv.19-22)
