MORNING MESSAGE

“Time To Go Home”

Luke 24:36-53

- I. THE APPEARANCE TO THE CROWD (vv.36-43)
 - A. It was a confusing appearance (vv.36-37)
 - B. It was a convincing appearance (vv.38-43)
- II. THE ASSIGNMENT TO THE CHURCH (vv.44-49)
 - A. The message of the church (vv.44-46)
 1. The message was predicted (v.44a)
 - a. Luke 9:22, “The Son of man must suffer many things, and be rejected of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be slain, and be raised the third day”
 - b. Luke 18:31-33, “Behold, we go up to Jerusalem, and all things that are written by the prophets concerning the Son of man shall be accomplished. For he shall be delivered unto the Gentiles, and shall be mocked, and spitefully entreated, and spitted on: and they shall scourge him, and put him to death: and the third day he shall rise again”
 2. The message was prophesied (vv.44b-45)
 3. The message was proclaimed (v.46)
 - B. The mission of the church (vv.47-48)
 1. The mission is pointed (v.47a)
 2. The mission is particular (v.47b)
 - a. Acts 1:8, “But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth”
 3. The mission is personal (v.48)
 4. The mission is powerful (v.49)
- III. THE ASCENSION TO THE CROWN (vv.50-53)
 - A. There was an exit (vv.50-51a)
 - B. There was an entrance (v.51b)
 1. 1 Peter 3:22, “Who is gone into heaven; and is on the right hand of God”
 - C. There was an exaltation (vv.52-53)
