MESSAGE

“Christmas in the Old Testament” Part 4

Luke 24:25-27

- I. BEFORE HE COMES
 - A. These are the prophecies of who He will be
 - 1. He will be the promised seed of Abraham
 - 2. He will be a descendant of Isaac
 - 3. He will be a descendant of David
 - 4. He will be from the tribe of Judah
- II. WHEN HE COMES
 - A. These are the prophecies of what He will do
 - 1. He will flee into Egypt
 - 2. He will be heralded by a messenger
 - 3. He will be anointed by the Spirit
 - 4. He will minister in Galilee
 - 5. He will be a prophet
 - 6. He will be stumbled over by the Jews
 - 7. He will be rejected by the Jews
 - 8. He will ride into town on a donkey
 - 9. He will be betrayed by a friend
 - 10. He will be sold for 30 pieces of silver
 - 11. He will be silent when accused
 - 12. He will be smitten and spat upon
 - 13. He will be pierced in his hands and feet
 - 14. He will be crucified with sinners
 - 15. He will be mocked and insulted
 - 16. He will be given gall and vinegar to drink
 - 17. He will be pierced in His side
 - 18. He will not have one broken bone
 - 19. He will be buried with the rich
 - 20. He will rise from the dead
- III. HE WILL COME
 - A. These are the prophecies about His return
 - 1. John 14:3, “And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you unto myself; that where I am there ye may be also”
 - 2. 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17, “For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord”
 - 3. There are more prophecies about the second of Jesus than there are about the first coming of Jesus
